REPORT BACK ON VISIT TO WESTERN ZAMBIA

July 2017

The team that took part in the short-term mission to Western Zambia in July consisted of 22 people which included people from various churches and three teachers from Emmanuel Private School.

The team connected well and there was a happy positive atmosphere in the camp.



PRE SCHOOLS

The schools are going well and the teachers from Emmanuel Private school spent time training and encouraging local teachers. The children were once again issued with summer and winter school clothes and both schools are receiving a meal each school day.



SANKANDI PRE SCHOOL

The children are progressing well and the school is highly esteemed by the local community. A fun day was held at the school where the children put on a performance for the team and the teachers challenged the ladies of the team to a soccer match. Much fun was had by all.



KABULA ONE PRE SCHOOL

We are very happy with Kabula One Pre School as the teachers are committed, the children are well behaved and the Headman (Induna) is appreciative of all that we do and is actively involved in the school. We were treated to a fun day where we enjoyed their traditional dancing as well as their recital of Bible verses. They also challenged our team to a tug of war.



SIKUKA PRE SCHOOL

We are assisting Trail Ministries with this school which was opened by them in June this year. Their teachers were included in our training programme and a fun day was held for the children.



EVANGELISM

Our teams visited the villages each day where they spread the gospel and prayed for the people. Our main Evangelism thrust, however, was the Jesus Film which we showed for five nights in various villages. This film was shown in SiLozi which is the local language. Many people gave their lives to Christ through this and in two of the villages, the entire village responded to the gospel. Time was spent before the film connecting with the people through soccer and other games. We thank Piet and Joan Bekker for making this possible and for their commitment throughout the week.



LADIES PRACTICAL

Maureen once again spent time knitting with the local ladies. Our ladies team held meetings with the ladies from Sankandi and Kabula One where they shared a word and made beaded bracelets together.

Our men were concerned about the condition of the Kabula School building. They assisted the ladies in mudding the walls where they had disintegrated because of the weather. They also fitted doors on the classrooms and repaired the Jungle Gym.



KABULA TWO

The team visited and interacted with Kabula Two village where there are 130 children in need of a Pre School. The Jesus film was shown in this village and was well received.

The team ministered in song and Word at the local church on Sunday.
