



# ZAMBIA MISSION UPDATE

## WESTERN ZAMBIA

### REPORT BACK ON JUNE/JULY MISSION

June/July 2015

*The team consisted of nineteen people of all ages who left at midnight on the 26th June, overnighted in Botswana and arrived in Sankandi on the 28th June.*

*The following is a summary of the ministries undertaken whilst in Zambia.*

#### VILLAGE MINISTRY

Our village ministry team went out to the villages each day where we visited the people, prayed for them and administered First Aid where needed. We were blessed to have the help of Ethel who is a nursing sister. Eleven people gave their lives to Christ through this ministry. The team was well received in the villages.



#### MEN'S PRACTICAL

Our men erected Jungle Gym's at both the Kabula One and Sioma Pre Schools. They also painted the mud walled building in Kabula One and painted our rainbow on the outside. They also erected a water filter at the local

Chief's village and relocated the solar panels in order to increase the power capacity for increased water supply to the school and the community.



#### LADIES PRACTICAL

Maureen once again worked with the ladies teaching them knitting and sewing skills.



### SANKANDI PRE SCHOOL

We are blessed to have Grace administer the Sankandi Pre School as well as give leadership to the other two schools. There are 74 children in Sankandi. They are progressing well and the teachers are coping with the curriculum.

### KABULA PRE SCHOOL.

The community erected their own mud walled classrooms and we opened this school in January, supplying all their teaching equipment. They now have 94 children attending who have never been to any school before. We were amazed to see the development of both the children and the teachers at Kabula One. The children are very well behaved and attentive and the Induna(headman) is very appreciative of what we are doing and takes personal interest in the school.

### SIOMA PRE SCHOOL

Akufuna and Khanyiso began a Pre School in Sioma toward the end of last year under a tree at their home. They have now erected a reed building for the children. We are assisting them with teaching materials and workbooks for the children. They have fifty children attending which are divided into two classes. We gave the children in all three schools uniforms that consist of shirts, jerseys and beanies. Sankandi children also received skirts and shorts.



We have begun feeding the children in all three the schools as they are experiencing drought in Zambia and the crops have failed this year. This has resulted in many families being without food. Fun days were held at all the schools on Friday where the entire team was involved.



### CAMPFIRES

We held two campfire meetings, one in Sioma and One in Kabula One. At the Kabula One Campfire almost everyone who attended, including the Induna, committed their lives to Jesus. We were privileged to have three people from Sweden join our team this year. The team was passionate in their love for God and the people. The entire team worked hard and achieved much.
