The new pre-school building was officially opened on the 27<sup>th</sup> June. The building was sponsored by the Uppsala Pentecostal Church of Sweden. The opening ceremony was attended by local education representatives Mr Katanekwa with two colleagues and Bishop Silwamba and his wife Rev Kalinda Silwamba of the POAG Western Province. The village Induna (Headman) presented the Uppsala Church with a carved elephant and three live chickens as a thank you gift. A Kingsway church under the PAOG was established in Kabula One on the same day by Bishop Silwamba.

## Kabula One

The Kabula One community face many challenges and education is one of the many problems. There are no schools in the village and the older children have to walk 9 km to school in Sankandi. Currently these children are not attending school as there is a severe drought in Western Zambia and they do not have the stamina for the walk. Our vision is to start a class for the grades in the new building in the afternoons

A fun day was held at Sankandi School where the children entertained the team with songs and Bible verses. New school uniforms were handed to the children in the new Kingsway colours. Teacher Grace and her staff are doing a great work in Sankandi.



## Kingsway Schools

Emmanuel Private School is currently writing a curriculum based on the ACE system which will be suitable for rural areas. This will be introduced to our schools early 2020. We continue to feed the children each school day and provide them with both winter and summer clothing once a year. The schools are going well and are recognized positively by the community.
